ECWG Exploration and Field Research Grant Program Recipients:

Our student grant program is partially financed by those whose contributions are greater than the annual ECWG dues amount. Eighty-five members made special donations to the grant fund in the 2015.

The ECWG grant program received fourteen applications for 2015. Applications were reviewed by the Grants Committee, and grants were awarded to the following five applicants:

FY 2015 Financial Report

As stated in the ECWG Articles of Procedure:

ECWG was granted tax-exempt status under sec. $501 \, @(3)$ of the Internal Revenue Code in 1990, was incorporated in the State of Delaware, and received a certificate of authority to operate in the District of Columbia in 1994. It was granted tax-exempt status by the District in 1998.

The Short Form 990-EZ - Return of Organization Exempt From Income Tax - for fiscal year beginning July 1, 2014 and ending June 30, 2015, was filed with the Internal Revenue Service and Club headquarters by ECWG Treasurer Bruce Blanchard on November 14, 2015.

As it has remained for 17 years, our annual ECWG base dues for 2015 were \$25.00 per person.

During fiscal year 2015, ending June 30, 2015, our net worth increased only \$736 this year. We transferred \$5,000 from our operations account to our exploration (student grant) account, and we bought a new Sony PXW-X70 camera for almost \$3,000. Overall, the end-of-year operations account decreased from \$10,532 to \$3,582. We awarded 5 grants, amounting to \$11,249 to graduate students in our area, and our grant account ended the year up \$1,946 for an end-of-year total of \$30,389. The provisional LTAD distribution, now amounting to \$39,976, is being held in a separate account pending recommendations from our Grants Committee concerning our intended payout schedule in the future.

As of June 30, 2015, we had 208 dues payers out of a total membership of 291 members (71%). This is a slightly smaller percentage than last year (73%).

Video Library: ECWG has 240 recorded dinner lectures on DVDs. The lectures, recorded from 17 October 1987 through 5 December 2015, have been transferred to DVDs. All DVDs were reviewed and verified by Board Members this year. The Board resolved to ensure that these DVDs are available for purchase.
